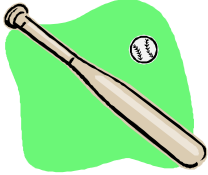




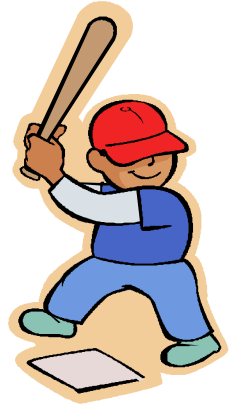

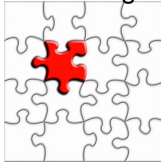

CMEO helps fight childhood obesity

Come Check out the new Market and Deli! As one of our oldest exhibits, the Market and Deli recently got a much needed remodel. More than a make-believe grocery store, the Market and Deli exhibit was remodeled with an emphasis on healthy eating choices and nutrition education.



The exhibit comes fully stocked with a variety of healthy “fresh”, “packaged” and “frozen” products in a newly constructed produce stand, dairy and bakery cases and stocked shelves. The exhibit also features a new deli element with a sandwich making station. Children visiting CMEO will stimulate their imaginations and appetites as they explore these key subjects: math and metrics, weighing and measuring, product categories, meal planning, nutritional choices, grocery store economics, careers and role playing, and ethnic foods and cultural diversity.

Childhood obesity is a pressing problem facing families today. Helping children understand where their food comes from and how to eat a healthy, well-balanced diet while being active is important for all families today if we are going to turn the tide on the childhood obesity epidemic we find in our country. And the new Market and Deli exhibit aims at doing just that. While playing in this exhibit, children and parents will be exposed to new produce, will learn how to make healthy choices from the educational materials on the exhibit walls, and special programs hosted by CMEO staff.

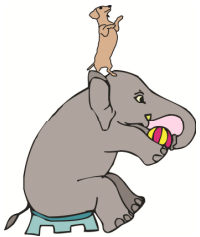
The Market and Deli exhibit remodel was made possible through a generous grant from the Pendleton Foundation Trust as well as donated services from Deutz Construction.

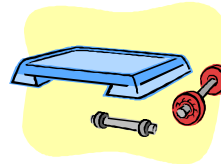
